The Dog Control Orders (Prescribed Offences and Penalties, etc.)
Regulations 2006 (S.I.2006/1059)
Dog on a Lead (Parish of Althorne) Order 0001

Althorne Parish Council hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order comes into force on 1st June 2011
2. This Order applies to the land specified in the Schedule 1.

Offence

3

(1) A person in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if, at any time, on any land to which this Order applies he/she does not keep the dog on a lead, unless—

(a) he has a reasonable excuse for failing to do so; or

(b) the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to his/her failing to do so.

(2) For the purposes of this article a person who habitually has a dog in his possession shall be taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog.

Penalty

4

A person who is guilty of an offence under article 3 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
