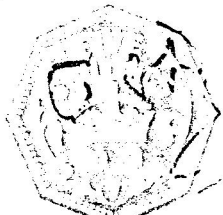

as to erection of War Memorial upon land of the Company
at Althorne, in the County of Essex.

This Deed made the *seventh* day of *July* one thousand nine hundred and twenty-*four* BETWEEN THE LONDON AND NORTH EASTERN RAILWAY COMPANY (hereinafter called "the Company") of the one part and THE ALTHORNE PARISH COUNCIL (hereinafter called "the Council") of the other part

1. THE Company do hereby consent to the Council entering upon the piece of land of the Company situate at the commencement of the Station Approach at Althorne in the County of Essex and shown by red colour upon the plan hereto annexed and erecting thereon a war memorial The said memorial shall at all times be kept in proper and efficient repair by the Council

2. THE foregoing consent is subject to the right of the Company and of all other persons entitled to a similar right to maintain repair renew reconstruct and use all pipes drains and other works that may now be laid in and under the said land and in and under the roadways surrounding the same and with power for the Company and such other persons as aforesaid to break up the surface of the said roadway so far as may be necessary and if or by reason of the erection of the said war memorial any pipes drains or other works laid under the said land shall be damaged or interfered with such damage or interference shall be made good by and at the expense of the Council and to the satisfaction of the Company's Chief Civil Engineer (Great Eastern Section)

3. NOTWITHSTANDING the consent hereinbefore contained the owners of any mines and minerals lying under or near the said piece of land shall be at liberty to exercise all such rights if any as they may possess in respect of or in connection with the working and carrying away of the said mines and minerals or any other mines and minerals

4. THE Council shall maintain any fencing or gates which
